

Great Romantic Masters

Mahler and Elgar are amongst the greatest of orchestral composers, loved by audiences because of the intense emotions

that are a hallmark of their music. Elgar's First Symphony ranges through catastrophe, nostalgia and haunting serenity to the triumph of its closing pages and has been at the centre of both Richard Hickox's and BBC NOW's repertoire for many years.

Baritone Wolfgang Holzmair, who made such an impression with his performance of Mahler's Songs of a Wayfarer in 2002, returns with the gentle and introspective Rückert Lieder.






